Plan Topic: Getting Along in Work Place/Compromising

School: Harnett County Schools

Objective Being Taught	S-11: TO Understand how to make compromises in order to get along with others.
RTLE Matrix Objective	Using role play and explicit teaching methods, provide opportunities for practicing appropriate social skills and decision making.
Student Audience/Length	OCS, Life Skills (High School) 1-2 Hours/ 2 Days
Materials/Resources Needed	Small Groups Marker, Paper Activity sheet (T- Chart) Resources: www.dannypetry.com
Teaching Procedure	Break students up into small groups of 3 or 4 and have students discuss the topic of compromise. Allow students to be creative. Discuss the pros and cons of compromise on a t-chart. Bring the class back together for a teacher directed discussion.
Check for Understanding and Assessment of Lesson	Teacher provides a scenario and students offer a compromise to resolve the issue. Let students be creative with problem solving i.e. debate, t-chart, discussion, role play.
Wrap Up/Review	Summary of Activity. Teacher directs conversation on compromise in the work place.
