Topic/Title of Plan: Exploring Post-Secondary Options

Objective Being Taught	Exploring post-secondary education opportunities with students through the internet Road to College
RTLE Matrix Objective	Explore college options with students and families through internet, visits to college campuses, and transition fairs.
Student Audience/Length	OCS/High School Students/3-4 days depending on students
Materials/Resources Needed	Internet Access
Teaching Procedure	<p>Students will create a presentation on three post-secondary options. Students will view video on Thinkcollege.net. The video informs students of various post-secondary options available for students with intellectual disabilities.</p> <p>After viewing video, student will choose three colleges based on the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) College is located in North Carolina2) Financial aid options available to pay for program (federal aid such as Pell Grants, Supplemental Grants, Vocational Rehabilitation, community resources, private pay, scholarships, but not federal student loans)3) Programs offered
Check for Understanding and Assessment of Lesson	Students will demonstrate understanding through their presentation which should include all required components.
Wrap Up/Review	What did they learn about post-secondary options presented? Did they find a program in which they would like to attend?
