

# Roads to Learning and Earning

## Lesson Plan



**Topic/Title of Plan:** High School vs. College

**Lesson Developed by:** Sharon Hendrix and Bree Campfield

**School:** AYN and North Shelby School

<b>Objective Being Taught</b>	Students will explore and give examples on the similarities and differences between college and high school.
<b>RTLE Matrix Objective</b>	Using resources provided explain the distinct differences between high school and college to students and families.
<b>Student Audience/Length</b>	OCS students/ 1-2 hours/ High school students
<b>Materials/Resources Needed</b>	Poster board, markers, computer
<b>Teaching Procedure</b>	The students will work in groups. They will brainstorm a list of college roles and high school roles. The students will discuss what they have to do in high school and what they believe they will do in college. They will use a T-Chart in order to show this. After the students discuss in small groups they will compare what they have with what the other groups have. Then the teacher will help the students navigate through different college websites. We will make a new college list together as a whole group based on what we research on the websites.
<b>Check for Understanding and Assessment of Lesson</b>	Using a Venn Diagram they will have at least 3 differences and 3 similarities between college and high school.
<b>Wrap Up/Review</b>	The students will present Venn Diagrams and T-Charts to the teachers. They will show new information on the second diagram.
