Topic/Title of Plan: Laundry

Objective Being Taught	Laundry, Community Living
RTLE Matrix Objective	By reviewing functional life skill resources, provide students and families with skills for living as independently as possible in the community.
Student Audience/Length	Middle or High School, 45 minutes
Materials/Resources Needed	You will need your dirty clothes, any kind of liquid laundry detergent, a washing machine (connected to power and water), and the desire to get the job done http://jennifermaddrell.com/ist541/Project3/wash.html
Teaching Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Separate dirty clothes your clothes into a light colored pile and a dark colored pile.• Use the dial on the washing machine to start the washing machine.• Load the washing machine with your dirty clothes.• Add detergent to the washing machine.• Close the washing machine's lid. Wait until the washing cycle has been completed before getting your clothes.
Check for Understanding and Assessment of Lesson	Wash laundry independently.
Wrap Up/Review	Reflect on the process and discuss what should be done differently, or not.
