Topic/Title of Plan: Uncle Sam Needs You!

School: High school juniors or seniors (must be 18)

Objective Being Taught	Registering to vote
RTLE Matrix Objective	Guide families to adult resources needed for establishing long term medical needs, financial planning, guardianship, voting and photo IDs
Student Audience/Length	Students who are 18 years of age/45-90 minutes
Materials/Resources Needed	Voter Registration form - can download at this website: https://enr.ncsbe.gov/cbeseach/ Obtain mailing address - here is a good website to use to find the address in your county: https://enr.ncsbe.gov/cbeseach/ Envelopes (Postage may depend on your school and the student IEP)
Teaching Procedure	Discuss the ability to vote in our country. Currently in NC, you must be 18 to register to vote. Provide a copy of the registration form and have students fill out their personal information. This may bring up the need to know certain personal information like a social security number, as well as having a driver's license or a personal identification card (which is a good alternative form of identification). Once the students have their information completely filled out, have them label an envelope with the address for your local Board of Election (BOE). Depending on your school policy, you may be able to mail the forms with postage paid by your school. (If this is a transition activity listed in the student's IEP, the school should pay the postage).
Check for Understanding and Assessment of Lesson	Completed form and addressed envelope
Wrap Up/Review	Place registration form in an envelope and mail to local BOE
